Librarian's report:

-No new architects have been contacted at this time to ask for their thoughts on possible library expansion. The board will hopefully be able to have at least one more presentation at the November meeting and then present our information to council in December.

-The Maker's Center has been very popular. Many kids are bringing their friends along with them and while they are here, they are also checking out books.

-The mayor has signed a proclamation proclaiming that next week is National Friends of the Library week. To celebrate, Sue has several special activities planned: story time, journal making for teens and adult coloring. The adult coloring session has a waiting list of 20 names.

-Preschool story time has begun again and it has been popular and well attended.

-Carpets have been cleaned

-The proceeds from the Lion's Club circus were \$730.50 and the book sale proceeds were \$237.75. These amounts have been added to the Friends' funds. The Friends will be purchasing a new CPU for the standing computer stand and items for the Maker's center
