City of Prairie City:

The Prairie City, City Council has amended the Fireworks Ordinance for our Community. The new regulations have already taken affect. Below are the dates that Fireworks will be allowed to be exploded.

Fireworks are allowed ONLY during the following times:

July 1 through July 8: from 6:00 p.m. through 10:00 p.m.

December 20 through January 1: from 6:00 p.m. through 10:00 p.m.

Extended Holiday Dates and Times:

July 3: 6:00 p.m. through 11:00 p.m.

July 4: 6:00 p.m. through 11:00 p.m.

December 31: 6:00 p.m. through 12:30 a.m. (January 1)

The use or exploding of Fireworks are prohibited at any other date and time throughout the year.

Leaving fireworks debris on roadways, public property, and property not owned by the participant can be considered littering which is citable offense. Please be kind and courteous and pickup any and all fireworks debris that falls on any public or privately owned property.
