The City Council of the City of Prairie City, Jasper County, Iowa, met on July 25, 2018, at City Hall in regular session at 6:30 P.M. Mayor Chad D. Alleger called the meeting to order and asked everyone to rise for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Roll was called showing members present as follows: Present: Councilors: Mayor Pro Tem Kuecker, Lindsay and Taylor. Also in attendance: City Manager/Chief of Police Bartello, City Clerk Kane. Absent: Mayor Alleger; Councilors: Beiner and Lee.

Consent Agenda:

Approval of Stampede Outdoor Service Liquor License for Prairie Days. Councilor Taylor moved to approve, and Councilor Lindsay seconded the motion. On a roll call vote, the motion carried unanimously.

Introduction and Adoption of Ordinances, Resolution, Public Hearings:

Mayor Pro Tem Kuecker opened a public hearing for re-zoning 301 W North Street at 6:36 P.M. No comments from the public. Public Hearing closed at 6:37 P.M.

Ordinance No. 362: Re-zoning of 301 W North Street (408 N. Park St.) from R3 (mobile home park) to R2 (multi-family housing). First Reading: Councilor Taylor moved to approve, and Councilor Lindsay seconded the motion. On a roll call vote, the motion carried unanimously.

Councilor Lindsay moved to waive the second and third readings of Ordinance No. 362 the re-zoning of 301 W North Street (408 N. Park St.) from R3 (mobile home park) to R2 (multi-family housing). Councilor Kuecker seconded the motion. On a roll call vote, the motion carried unanimously.

Resolution 07-25-18#1 – Support for endorsing the application for a REAP Grant through the Iowa Department of Natural Resources. Councilor Taylor moved to approve the application, and Councilor Lindsay seconded the motion. On a roll call vote, the motion carried unanimously.

Melanie Umble of Shomo, Madsen and Umble, addressed the Council regarding additional insurance coverage for the Friends of the Library Group. Under the City EMC insurance policy, the Friends of Library may be added as an additional insured for special projects and fundraisers for liability.
