Implementation Date: November 10, 2021 Last Reviewed/Update Date: October 20, 2021

SECTION 1. PURPOSE The Public Records Request Policy defines the procedures and fees associated with handling public records requests to the City of Prairie City, Iowa. It is the policy of the City of Prairie City, Iowa, to respond in an orderly and expeditious manner following Iowa Code Chapter 22 to requests to inspect or receive copies of public records maintained by the City of Prairie City.

SECTION 2. APPLICABILITY

This policy applies to all City departments, except the Police Department, which has their own public records policy.

SECTION 3. BACKGROUND

The City of Prairie City recognizes the right of the public to access public records maintained by the City following state law. The City also recognizes that certain records maintained by the City are not public records or may be exempt from public disclosure and that a request to access public records may require a balance of the right of the public to access the records, individual privacy rights, governmental interests, confidentiality issues, and privilege issues. Additionally, when the City responds to requests to inspect or copy records, costs are incurred by the City. This policy is adopted to balance these competing interests, to establish an orderly and consistent procedure for responding to public records requests, and to support the adoption of a fee schedule designed to reimburse the City for the actual costs incurred in responding to public records requests.

SECTION 4. DESIGNATED CUSTODIAN

Iowa Code Section 22.1 (2) requires government bodies to delegate an official or employee as its "lawful custodian" responsible for implementing the requirements of Iowa Code Chapter 22 and to provide that information to the public. The City's "lawful custodian" is the City Administrator/City Clerk or any employee delegated such responsibilities by the City Administrator/City Clerk.

SECTION 5. PUBLIC RECORDS REQUESTS

The following procedures shall be followed in responding to requests to inspect or receive copies of public records maintained by the City of Prairie City.

A. Records requests may come in the form of a letter, email, fax, or verbal request. To accurately and timely process a records request, the City needs to know the full extent and how to contact the requestor in case the City Administrator/City Clerk, or their designee has any questions or concerns. If possible, the requestor should put his or her request in writing using the City of Prairie City's Public Records

B. Any request for public records maintained by the City of Prairie City, except for police records, must be referred to the City Administrator/City Clerk's office for review of the request, collection of the records, and completion of the request.

C. The fee to be charged for providing records in response to a public records request will be following the most current fee schedule adopted by the City Council.

a. At the requestor's preference, the City may make the requested records available in hard copy or electronic format. The requestor may ask the City to supply copied records either by mail, electronic mail, fax, or pick up at Prairie City City Hall

b. The City reserves the right to adjust the fee structure for extraordinary requests and provide a cost estimate to the

requestor before request completion.

D. The person requesting public records can request the City to prepare an estimate of the charges that will be incurred to respond to the public records request. The City may also require an advance deposit of the estimated charges before copying any of the requested records available for inspection or copying. If the actual costs incurred by the City to respond to a records request are less than the amount of any required prepayment, the overpayment will be refunded promptly to the person or entity making the prepayment. If the actual costs incurred by the City to respond to the request are more than the amount of prepayment, the City shall charge the requestor for all additional costs.

E. Unless otherwise prohibited by law, the City may, at the City's discretion, furnish copies of requested records without charge or at a reduced fee if the City determines that the waiver or reduction of fees

is in the public interest.

F. The City shall provide a reasonable opportunity for the inspection, examination, or copying of requested public records, which are not exempt from disclosure. Unless otherwise approved in advance and in writing by the City Administrator/City Clerk's office, any inspection, examination or copying of requested records shall be done at Prairie City City Hall during regular City business hours.

G. The City reserves the right to not release copies of requested public records until the requestor pays for the corresponding charges to

complete the said request.

SECTION 6. FEE SCHEDULE

The following fees and costs may be charged according to Iowa Code Chapter 22 for access and/or copies of public records maintained by the City of Prairie City.

The following fees were approved by Resolution in March of 2021:

If the requestor chooses to have records mailed to them, postage will be charged at actual cost.

The City will provide fifteen (15) minutes of City staff time free of charge

to respond to each requestor. Requestors will be charged \$5.00 for each additional fifteen (15) minutes of service.

Some requests may need to be reviewed by the City Attorney. In such circumstances, the requestor will be billed for the time spent by the City Attorney at the attorney's hourly rate as determined by the attorney's current contract with the City of Prairie City.

SECTION 7. ESTIMATED RESPONSE TIME

The anticipated response times below are approximations:

SECTION 8. DISCLAIMER

Although records provided to a requestor may be deemed "open" or "public records" within the meaning of Iowa Code Chapter 22, the City recommends that requestors ensure use of any information provided by the City comply with all local, state, and federal laws, including but not limited to laws related to privacy, harassment, discrimination, debt collection, libel, slander, and tort.

As part of a grant from the U.S. Forest Service, communities, schools, counties, and residents within city limits, are eligible for free seedlings from the State Forest Nursery, in Ames, Iowa. Trees can be ordered in increments of 25 up to a maximum of 200. Trees can be picked-up in Ames or shipped for free. ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS: Sites eligible for planting these trees are anywhere, as long as the trees are planted within city limits. Trees can be handed-out individually from a distribution center or be given to a group of citizens to plant. If you have a Tree Board, FFA club, Boy/Girl Scout troop or any other organization looking for a project to improve the community, they may be able to help with getting the trees planted. Applying organizations need NOT participate in the Trees for Kids program to receive seedlings! However, if you do have kids involved we would like to know.


