CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
APRIL 28, 2022**

CALL MEETING TO ORDER AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: The City Council of Prairie City, Jasper County, Iowa, met on April 28, 2022, in special session at the Prairie City Council Chambers at City Hall and via Zoom. At 6:02 p.m. Mayor Imerman called the meeting to order, and all joined in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.
