## Residential Curbside Clean-up

- Please place materials neatly at the curb in front of your property before 7:00 am the day of pick-up and not more than 24 hours in advance. Waste Management will make one trip through town and does not return to town to pick up items placed on the curb after that time.
- Please pick up any items not removed from the curb within 24 hours of this event to avoid a citation.

#### **THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE NOT ALLOWED AND WILL NOT BE PICKED UP:**

- Construction debris (including drywall, lathes, boards, etc.)
- Rolls of carpet
- Oil
- Paint (empty, dry cans are allowed)
- Appliances
- Televisions
- Computers
- Air Conditioners
- Yard waste
- Tires/Rims
- Car batteries
- Regular household garbage
- Metal
- Car or bicycle parts
- Eaves spouts
- Hazardous waste

#### ***OTHER OPTIONS FOR DISPOSAL OF ITEMS not INCLUDED IN THE CURBSIDE CLEAN-UP:***

Stickers may be purchased at City Hall for disposal of appliances, televisions, and computers. You may also contact Car Country @ 1-800-252-2886 to drop off appliances and scrap metal at 2713 IA-14 Newton, IA 50208

Residents within the city limits may also take car batteries, corrosives, flammables, toxic materials, reactive materials, paints and oil products to the Regional Collection Center in Bondurant at 1105 Prairie Drive SW. Please call 515-967-5512 for information. The collection center is open year-round.
