CITY COUNCIL MINUTES
DECEMBER 19, 2022

CALL MEETING TO ORDER AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: The City Council of Prairie City, Jasper County, Iowa, met on December 19, 2022, in special session at the Prairie City Council Chambers at City Hall and via Zoom. At 11:32 p.m., Mayor Alleger called the meeting to order and all joined in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance.

ROLL CALL: Roll was called showing members present and absent as follows: Present in-person– Mayor Alleger, present via Zoom Councilors Simmons, Ingle, and Townsend. Not present Holland and Laidig. Also, in attendance in-person: City Clerk Busby.
