

Seasonal Mowing Job Description

Department: Public Works **Title**: Seasonal Mower **Hourly Rate**: \$14.00 per hour

Work Hours: Monday - Friday 7 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. availability, 20-30 hours a week, depending on weather.

Additional hours as assigned by the Interim Public Works Superintendent and/or Administrator.

[FLSA: Non-exempt]

Supervisor: Interim Public Works Superintendent and/or City Administrator

Job Description: Under general supervision of the Interim Public Works Superintendent and/or City Administrator, employee will assist with mowing, weed trimming, and other duties as required.

Work setting is outdoors to include parks and cemetery.

Knowledge/ Abilities/Skills: Ability to operate commercial lawn mowing equipment, tractors, and general handheld tools.

- Ability to work outside under any type of weather conditions and to withstand physically demanding work such as lifting, stooping, and bending.
- Ability to lift and move 50 pounds regularly. Ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with other employees and the general public.
- Ability to follow oral and written instructions.

Essential Duties: While performing the duties of this job, the employee is regularly required to stand, walk, sit, use hands to finger, handle, or feel objects, tools, or controls, reach with hands and arms, and communicate (speak and/or hear). The employee is frequently required to stoop, kneel, or crouch. The employee is required to climb and balance. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distant vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception, and the ability to adjust focus.

Work Environment: The work environment characteristics described here are representative of those an employee encounters while performing the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions. While performing the duties of this job, the employee may work near moving mechanical parts in outside weather conditions. The employee may be exposed to fumes or airborne particles. The noise level in the work environment may be loud.

Qualifications: High school diploma or equivalent. Must be 18 years of age.

Special Requirements: Possession of a valid lowa driver's license.
